

## **Disbursements Typically Not Permitted**

Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and other government benefits are received by the beneficiary to cover basic needs such as food and shelter. If the disbursements are made from a special needs trust for basic needs, a beneficiary may lose all or part of his/her government benefits.

## The following is a list of disbursements typically not permitted:

- Food or groceries
- Rent or mortgage payments
- Property taxes\*
- Heating fuel (gas, oil)
- Electricity
- Water
- Sewer
- Garbage collections service

## The following is a list of items that are strictly prohibited:

- Cash given directly to the beneficiary for any purpose
- Gifts
- Cigarettes
- Alcohol
- Firearms
- Fireworks
- Pawn shop purchases
- Casino/gambling money

\*Note: In certain emergency situations, payment of property taxes or other annual shelter costs may be requested.
